1. Methods for reporting production:

- LU = Land Use
- WM = Water Meter

2. Source areas are as follows:

- AS1 - UPPER CARMEL VALLEY - San Clemente Dam to Esquiline Bridge
- AS2 - MID CARMEL VALLEY - Equiline Bridge to Narrows
- AS3 - LOWER CARMEL VALLEY - Narrows to Via Mallorca Bridge
- AS4 - LOWER CARMEL VALLEY - Via Mallorca Bridge to Lagoon
- SCB - SEASIDE COASTAL BASIN
- CAC - CACHAGUA CREEK and UPPER WATERSHED AREAS
- CVU - CARMEL VALLEY UPLAND - Hillsides and Tularcitos Creek Area
- LSS - LAGUNA SECA SUBAREA (Ryan Ranch Area is within LSS)
- MIS - PENINSULA, CARMEL HIGHLANDS, and SAN JOSE CREEK AREAS

3. This value includes 175.5 AF from San Clemente reservoir, 3,522.0 AF from Seaside wells, and 10,913.6 AF from Carmel Valley wells.

4. This value includes 12,634.4 AF for Cal-Am customers in its main system, 10.9 AF for Cal-Am customers in the former Rancho Fiesta Mutual area, and 144.2 AF for Cal-Am customers in the former Water West area. This value also includes 23.1 AF for backwash purposes, 4.7 AF for non-revenue metered use, 282.2 AF for non-revenue unmetered use, 3.7 AF for metered irrigation water, and 310.1 AF for Seaside injection.

5. N.A. refers to data that are not available.

6. Italicized numbers in "active connections" column are best estimates by District staff for reports that were received but failed to include current number.

7. Cachagua Road #1 and #2 were switched to agree with records of the Monterey County Health Dept. in Reporting Year 1999. Older MPWMD records have the names of these systems reversed.

8. Production and delivery figures in italics were adjusted to account for reports that did not include data for the entire Water Year, or reported data for a longer period.

9. Operated by California-American Water Company; Bishop Water Co. was acquired 7/99.

10. Delivered amount (10.9 AF) all produced by main Cal-Am system, so that amount has been added to Cal-Am system deliveries. Source of production was AS1-AS4.

11. Formerly reported as "Carmel Valley Mutual Water Company", annexed to Cal-Am in 1993.

12. Production from the Monterra desalination plant was 27.8 AF. Metered deliveries totaled 26.4 AF. Unaccounted for consumption from the desalination plant was 1.57 AF, or about 6% of production.
