

- 11/30/04 County Board of Supervisors initiated collaborative process. Regional Urban Water Supply (RUWS) project
- Board of Supervisors directed that MCWRA alternatives. agencies to develop RUWS project management convene senior managers of cities and water

#### Regional Approach to Solving **Urban Water Supply Issues** (Continued)

- "Working group" of senior managers met 12/23/04, 1/13/05, 2/17/05, and 3/10/05
- Managers concurred that regional approach provides greater:
- 1) overall benefit/cost-effectiveness;
- likelihood of success;
- supportive structure for individual entities' water supply efforts (e.g ASR, Purified/Recycled, etc);
- 4) near-and long-term solutions catalyzed.


