Dear Michael:

In response to your letter of December 7, 1989, this will confirm Cal-Am's acceptance of the conditions dated April 10, 1989 and November 13, 1989 as established by the Board of Directors of the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District.

As a point of clarification and to bridge compliance I will make the following comments regarding each set of conditions:

April 10, 1989

Condition 4

This establishes a requirement of monitoring regarding a February 1989 report by Staal, Gardner & Dunne, Inc. We would appreciate a copy of that report as we have never received one.

Condition 5

Meters have been installed, and production records are being maintained.

Condition 6

This has been discussed with the manager; we will read bimonthly rather than monthly.

November 18, 1989

Condition 7

This states that Cal-Am shall secure permits. It is our feeling that it is the tenant or owner's responsibility to secure permits from the district. With the proper permit we will then set meters in the subunit.

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Condition 8

This corrects condition 6 in the April 10, 1989 conditions.

Condition 9

It is my understanding that items "a" through "f" have been in compliance and reports have been supplied to the district by Cal-Am, acting as manager for the Ryan Ranch Mutual Water Company. Coordination has been established with Joe Oliver of your staff.

If any of these conditions are not as I have stated, please advise so that we can bring about immediate compliance.
