Dec. 2009 Adopted Strategic Plan and Water Supply Goals



Focus on priority projects:

- Regional water supply project
- MPWMD Water Project 1 (underground storage)
- MPWMD Water Project 2 (expanded storage)
- MPWMD Water Project 3 (local desalination)
- MRWPCA Groundwater Replenishment Project.



March 31, 2011 Goal Setting Session

- Continue Water Projects 1, 2 and 3
- Water Project 4 = Support
 Groundwater Replenishment Project
- Water Project 5 = Investigate Los Padres Dam Expansion
- Board to adopt record in April (item 2)
- Board to consider budget and work plan in May 2011



Regional Water Solutions and Partnerships

- Regional Project: CPUC approved project on December 2, 2010.
- Wrote April 12, 2011 letter to Cal-Am supporting pipeline and related facilities within District; advised of process to amend current WDS permit.



Water Project 1 (storage)



- Injection began Dec. 21, 2010 through Jan. 17, 2011; Feb. 16 – Mar. 16, 2011; March 18 to present.
- As of today, 758 AF injected in WY 2011.
- Continued work on facilities building, electrical control equipment, and Cal-Am pipeline easement.
- Continued coordination with Cal-Am re: system operation, and pending State Health approval to increase extractions.

Water Project 2 (storage)



- MPWMD and Cal-Am continue coordination on needed infrastructure for Well #1 and #2 planned next year.
- Cal-Am pipeline to Seaside Middle School well site in progress; also temporary backflush pipeline for Well #1.
- Draft water rights permit received from SWRCB; review in progress.
- First draft project description and hydrology impact update completed for planned CEQA Addendum.



Water Project 3 (local desal)



- District Engineer continues to work with Water Supply Planning Committee to describe three most promising desalination sites in Sand City as well as a site near Naval Postgraduate School (NPS).
- General Manager plans to meet with NPS Commandant by May 12, 2011.



Groundwater Replenishment



 Board committees and staff continue to coordinate with MRWPCA regarding the best ways to support the Groundwater Replenishment Project, including public education.



Water Distribution System Permits Update



- Status since March 21, 2011:
- Three new Applications to create a WDS, plus one revised subdivision proposal.
- One new application for a permanent mobile WDS.
- No new Pre-Applications.
- Assessment of fractured rock wells within the District continues; GIS analysis of 750 wells is underway.
