Ordinance No. 148 amends Rule 141, Water Conservation Rebates.

Summary

- Implements Resolution 2011-04 guidelines for Lawn removal Rebates
- Amends process to address depletion of Rebate Account funds



#### Other amendments include:

Summary

- Clarification that Rebate Sites must be in compliance with District rules;
- Disqualification of Qualified Devices that are mandated by law;
- Reordered language related to Ultra High Efficiency Toilets
- Deletes reference to a list of irrigation system controllers maintained by the District
- Clarifies deed restriction requirements for certain Rebates



### Time is of the essence

Summary

- Information from CPUC Division of Ratepayers Advocates that funding of 2011 Rebates from 2012-2014 General Rate Case (GRC) is not allowed
- Funding from the 2009-2011 GRC is anticipated to conclude in early May 2011 in the California American Water systems



# Recommendations

- Staff recommends the Board approve the second reading and adopt Ordinance No.
  148 to facilitate timely implementation of amendments regarding Rebate program funding.
- The effective date of this ordinance is May 1, 2011.
- This ordinance is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Class 1, 15301.
