Summary of Activities

- District and California American Water staff attended a conference on water efficiency and conservation.
- The District and California American Water will exhibit at the Monterey Peninsula Chamber of Commerce Business Expo on October 27, 2011, at the Monterey Conference Center. Objective: Provide information about the upcoming Non-Residential retrofit requirements.
- MPWMD will be sponsoring Level 200 rainwater harvesting workshop on February 24 -25. The training will be conducted by the American Rainwater Catchment Systems Association (ARCSA).



Irrigation Advice

It's time to reduce irrigation watering times:

- Shorter days and cooler fall weather reduces the amount of water plants use and need.
- Install a Rain Sensor on your automatic irrigation system –MPWMD residents/businesses can receive one free at the District's offices.
- Take advantage of efficient irrigation technology such as Weather-Based Irrigation Controllers, Soil Moisture Sensors and water efficient sprinkler nozzles.

- Graywater irrigation system
- Stormwater catchment basins
