Rule 11, Definitions

Rule 11



Revisions to the definitions of Recycled Water, Showerhead, Ultra High Efficiency Toilet (HET) and Urinal

Amendment to definition of Shower, Each Additional Fixture, to clarify that an "additional fixture" is each Showerhead beyond the first, with the exception of a single hand-held Showerhead that operates on a diverter.



The Cistern Rebate is increased by adding a higher rebate tier for the first 500 gallons of storage capacity

– Current maximum Cistern Rebate: \$6,250

Rule 141

– Proposed maximum Cistern Rebate: \$6,375

Due to limited funding for the Rebate Program, an amendment restricts Cistern Rebates to Sites supplied with water from the Monterey Peninsula Water Resource System



Rule 143, Existing Non-Residential



Retrofit requirements for Non-Residential uses currently scheduled for implementation on December 31, 2012, **are extended for 12 months to December 31, 2013**.

- High Efficiency Urinals
- High Efficiency Clothes Washers
- Water Efficient Ice Machines
- Non-Residential car wash facility reuse standard of 50 percent



Ordinance Review



Ord 151 (proposing these and other amendments) was reviewed and contained the definition revisions, the Rebate changes and an extended Non-Residential retrofit/replacement deadline.

Recommendation

- Staff recommends the Board approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 153.
- A Negative Declaration pursuant to CEQA will be considered at second reading. An initial study and notice of intent to adopt a negative declaration has been circulated and comments will be received through June 6, 2012.
