I understand that the Board will be considering a water permit for September Ranch in Carmel Valley at a meeting on Monday, November 19. If such a permit is allowed, I would strongly encourage the Board to direct CalAm to disconnect the entire Ranch project from any CalAm connections, since they claim they have plenty of water on their own. If they run out of water, CalAm would be obligated to provide it after the fact if there are connections. This happened at CV Ranch after many promises that they would not need CalAm water. I am concerned that the development may eventually take water that they should not rightfully have.
