1	Sec 6-A	Added amendment to 25.5-B to allow continued use of Table 2 for new construction of new structures.	<p>Amendments to Rule 142 in Ordinance 151 add requirements for High Efficiency Washing Machines and Dishwashers for Residential New Structures. Water Use Credits for structures that are demolished are documented based on the fixtures that exist at the time of demolition and are granted pursuant to Rule 25.5.</p> <p>Reconstruction of a demolished Residential structure often relies on previously documented Water Use Credits. Without the amendment to Rule 25.5-B, the value of previously documented Water Use Credits that may be relied upon to design a replacement structure would be reduced.</p>
2	Sec 6-B	Clarification under Instant-Access Hot Water System (IAHWS) that Water Use Credit is not available for IAHWS in New Structures	Consistent with current and long-standing policy. Without this clarification and with the amendment to Rule 25.5-B (#1), IAHWS would be available and would need further CEQA consideration as it would reduce water savings resulting from current policy.
3	Sec 8-I	Changed "Lavatory Faucets" to "Washbasins"	Consistent terminology
