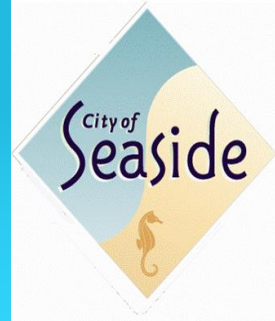

ShowerStart “Ladybugs” available now at MPWMD*

What is a Ladybug Adapter?

- The ShowerStart Ladybug Adapter is installed between the showerhead and shower arm (pipe)
- It saves water and energy by conserving the hot water that is typically wasted while waiting for shower water to become warm
- When combined with a low-flow showerhead (1.5 gpm), the Ladybug increases the showerhead's efficiency by 22% – 50% depending upon the water heater and residence type

Your morning routine without wasting water:



Turn On

Start your shower...

The water will be cold, so just walk away and finish your morning routine. Your shower will run until the water is hot.



Get Ready

ShowerStart kicks in...

Brush your teeth, make your bed, or simply finish your coffee. When the water reaches 95°F, ShowerStart slows shower to a trickle, saving hot water until you're ready to get in.



Get In

It's ready when you are.

You know your shower is warm, so pull the cord and your shower will return to full, luxurious pressure.
