
Dear Sir/Madam:

I write to you concerning your most recent water bill and its relation to a water leak in the watering system for our yard (account # 1015-210018796765). We expected a large water bill for the previous month because we had just moved in, and the watering system was in the process of being installed. On November 5th we received a service noticed from Rick Saldivar about a leak from one of the Orbit manifold valves next to the house which we were aware of but mistakenly assumed that the leak was small. In any case since that notice we have had a service technician examine our watering system in an effort to find the problem. After several hours of work we think that the leak has been found but I will need to check the meter regularly (daily to weekly) to see if our water usage has gone down. This problem has been very frustrating and expensive, and we still are not sure that the problem has been completely solved. In any case, since we were not aware of the severity of this problem until we received our last bill, and since we are actively engaged in trying to solve the problem, do we possibly qualify for a discount on our latest water bill? Some compensation would be greatly appreciated.


