Summary of Ordinance 158



- Amends Rule 28-B, Water Use Credit Transfers
- Clarifies that Jurisdiction first reviews and approves any proposed Water Use Credit as CEQA lead agency
 - Makes a determination and findings before referring a transfer application to the District (the responsible agency)
- Final determination by the General Manager
 - Ensures all conditions of Rule 28 are met
- Staff decisions are appealable to the Board by public or Board member



Summary of Ordinance 158



- Letter received from attorney Molly Erickson on behalf of Save Our Carmel River (SOCR) (11/18/2013)
- Letter questioned CEQA determination and the ability of a Jurisdiction to adequately review a project's effects on the environment as a whole.
- The letter also expressed concern about notification of decisions and the cost to appeal a decision of the General Manager.
- Counsel advises that the Board may continue with consideration of adoption of Ordinance No. 158.



Recommendation



- The Board should receive public comment
- Consider second reading and adoption of Ordinance No. 158
