Notes:

Unaccounted-for-fish were most likely caused by predation of smaller fish.

Fish were segregated in the rearing channel by size/age at the start of the holding season, but many of the small, yoy fish were able to move up towards the head of the channel through small gaps in the screens, making it impossible to calculate the exact survival percentages in each bay. The overall rearing channel survival is correct.

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
