1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

2. PUBLIC COMMENT – Rod Mills asked the Committee to discuss well water use in Carmel Valley.

3. CONSENT CALENDAR – Lance Monosoff made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 28, 2010 Regular Meeting. Larry Levine seconded. The motion to approve the minutes passed by a unanimous vote.

4. UPDATE AND DISCUSSION ON CARMEL RIVER WATERSHED ACTIVITIES – Clive Sanders said that the Carmel River Watershed Conservancy (CRWC) has put a hold on work to install a protective barrier at the Carmel River lagoon. He indicated that the CRWC would like to move forward on a plan to create additional water storage at the lagoon, but that some of the affected property owners had expressed concerns about potential changes to views.

5. STAFF REPORTS –

a. Integrated Regional Water Management Planning - Larry Hampson reported that the Department of Water Resources had announced draft new guidelines for Proposition 84 grant funds.

b. San Clement Dam Alternatives – Hampson reported on a discussion between stakeholders that focused on identifying a federal funding and a federal agency that could accept ownership of the dam site and surrounding property. Investigations into these topics were to be completed by early summer 2010.

c. Update on California American Water Settlement Agreement with NOAA Fisheries – staff reported on completing applications to the Fisheries Restoration Grant Program for funds from the Settlement Agreement

d. Hampson gave a short presentation of engineered wood in rivers.
