1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

2. PUBLIC COMMENT – Margaret Robbins commented about a sewage spill on August 17, 2010 at Carmel Valley Ranch and asked for contact information to report such spills. John Dalessio stated that Carmel Valley Ranch had expressed an intent to develop additional units on the property and asked what the process would be to obtain a permit for water use from MPWMD. Andy Bell noted that in order to allow further development, water use may need to be reduced elsewhere on the property. Andy Bell was to confer with Stephanie Pintar, the MPWMD Demand Manager, about the process and report back to the Committee.

Clive Sanders reported on a proposal to establish a 120-horse stable in Cachagua Valley. The Committee requested that staff follow up with Mr. Sanders and report back to the Committee.

Rod Mills noted that the Carmel Valley airport had been used as a bivouac area for fire fighters during the 2008 Basin Complex and stated that he had spoken with the Carmel Valley Fire District about reserving eight to ten acres at the as a permanent site for emergency fire response operations.

3. CONSENT CALENDAR – Larry Levine made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 15, 2010 Regular Meeting. Lance Monosoff seconded. **The motion to approve the minutes passed by a unanimous vote.**

4. UPDATE AND DISCUSSION ON CARMEL RIVER WATERSHED ACTIVITIES – Clive Sanders said that the Carmel River Watershed Conservancy (CRWC) had been preparing grant applications. Lorin Letendre, the CRWC President, said the Conservancy was working with the National Marine Fisheries Service to set up a public meeting concerning issues at the Carmel River lagoon.

5. STAFF REPORTS

a. Integrated Regional Water Management Planning - Larry Hampson reported that MPWMD had

submitted a Planning Grant application for \$995,000 in grant funds to the Department of Water Resources from Proposition 84 funds and that MPWMD would facilitate an application in January 2011 for an Implementation Grant .

- b. Update on California American Water Settlement Agreement with NOAA Fisheries there was no change in the status of this program.
- c. Update on the San Clement Dam Removal Project Mr. Hampson reported that the Bureau of Land Management had agreed to acquire the San Clemente Dam property ant that a public meeting to would be held in late November 2010 by Cal-Am and the Coastal Conservancy to discuss progress on the project.
- d. Fall Carmel River Vegetation Management Andy Bell reported that Thomas Christensen was busy managing nine sites that were targeted for selective management.

Committee members scheduled the next committee meeting for January 20, 2011. The following topics were requested to be placed on a future agenda:


